# RESULTS, RESULTS!

For some time now we have been thinking about how best to reflect all the many achievements of our members in races. Lots of these go un reported but the fact is that there has been lots to shout about with some stand out results right across the board. So I have been asking members to report in on their race results with the aim of sharing the good news. Thanks to all those who have sent in their results to me – please keep them coming!

Here is our third "Results Roundup" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send in so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

This third Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (**January 2022**). A much quieter month post Christmas with most of the racing action taking place at the end of the month with the penultimate **PECO** race 4 – **West Park** – being the standout event with lots at stake especially for our ladies team. Not forgetting parkrun of course which also produced some great ACP performances. So here goes.....

Lots of mud to enjoy in January! All three of our race reports this month feature it in one way or another so lets kick off with the **Harewood Trail**Race – Half marathon and 10k versions on offer held in the expansive grounds of Harewood House on Saturday January 8<sup>th</sup>. Five of our runners took part with second claim member **Simon Jones** taking line honours in the Half with a rapid 1:25:06. He was being chased by two fast ladies – **Poppy Cartwright** 

finishing in 1:52:23 closely followed by **Sarah Lund** only 19 seconds behind in 1:52:42.

Enjoying the shorter version of mud therapy at **Harewood 10k** were **Louise Biddulph** (1:10:02) and **Mike Jarvis** making a welcome return to racing (though I'm not sure he felt that way about it at the end!) in 1:11:16

The very next day our runners made the trip over to another stately home — Temple Newsam House - for the very popular **TNT Temple Newsam Ten.**This is one of those races that fills within hours of going on sale and incorporates a good water splash within the ten mile course around the extensive hilly grounds — sound familiar? More than a dash of Chevin Chase in this one. Four of our intrepid lady runners made the journey over to East Leeds with **Brenda Peake** (1:31:09) leading our quartet home closely followed by **Sarah Podesta** in 1:39:42, **Louise Holloway-Cathcart** (1:42:29) and **Janice Chruscht** (1:47:02). Conditions on the day were "interesting" to say the least!

Our last "proper" race report for this month featured something very different – a race between runners and mountain bike riders up a steep fell and back down again all hosted by Wharfedale Harriers in the pretty dales village of **Appletreewick**. 186 runners and riders took up the challenge including our own **Alison Bolton** who decided to challenge her MTB riding partner to a "race within a race" for top dog family honours. Discretion prevents me from revealing who ended up doing the washing up but Alison ran a cracking 52:56 in a race where the first 17 finishers were MTB riders (have I given too much away!). If this sort of thing excites you, Bingley Harriers stage a very similar race in the summer – watch this space for the race alert!

That all brings us once again to **PECO!** 

This years PECO season is coming to an exciting conclusion, especially for our ACP Ladies team – **Race 4** of the five race Cross country series where getting very muddy, wet and exhausted is a badge of honour. It's a complicated format that would take a year to fully explain but essentially it's a team race where clubs race against each other with individual runners amassing points for the team and the team totals placing the club on a league ladder split into Mens and Ladies with a shorter 1 or 2 mile race for Juniors. This fourth race in the series took place at **West Park**, **Leeds** on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, over an approx 4.5 mile course. Muddy wet fields were the order of the day - 730 ran.
