# RESULTS, RESULTS!

It doesn't seem five minutes since our last Results Roundup hit the airwaves but here we are in April already heading for Easter with a bumper crop of race results to report. Thanks to all those who have sent in their results to me – please keep them coming!

So here is our fifth "Results Roundup" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send in so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

This fifth Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (March 2022). I've cheated a little bit because March ended just a day or two before a very busy race weekend which technically was April  $2^{nd} / 3^{rd}$  – but we make up our own rules so I've sneaked those in as well!

Thankfully March was a kinder month weather wise (could it have been worse than February ?) and I guess that is reflected in some of our results.

I'm not sure what conversation took place between **Amanda Connolly**, **Sharon Elms and Sue Hulme** over strong cocktails but somehow they contrived to agree to tackle the infamous **Armley Gotts Park Steps reps**. For those unfamiliar with this physical challenge ( it really belongs in some sadistic reality TV show) it involves running up and down a steep flight of 161 steps as often as possible until your heart gives out! Believe it or not there is a website devoted to this madness. Our gallant trio gave it their best shot and completed 15 flights in one hour. This is a calorie burn of 1000 and listed benefits include – Toning of Bum and Thighs (I haven't verified this yet), Burns twice the amount of fat than a normal run, Low impact & safe for knees

How do you follow that ? Well on 12<sup>th</sup> March four of our lady runners ventured up to Dent in the Northern dales to run the lovely Dent 14 mile road race. Now I can say that I have run this race in prep for my 2015 London Marathon attempt and it is a lovely race in idyllic Dales countryside. The race raises funds for the local village school. Adding to the allure is the fact that Dent boasts two terrific pubs but I'm sure that didn't play into the decision to run it. First home for ACP in 1:55:09 was Sarah Lund followed by Helen Waite (2:11:34), Carole Keighley (2:21:42) and Janice Chruscht (2:30:11)

The following day a posse of six Pacers made the trip up to **Thirsk** for the annual 10 mile road race – a gently undulating PB course starting and finishing at Thirsk racecourse. **Andrew Humphries** ran a superb race to finish **4**<sup>th</sup> **overall in 53:48**, **Richard Walker** (tuning up for Manchester Marathon) **next in 1:02:44** and followed in by **Derek Lee** (1:11:05), **Owain Gwilym** (1:13:04), **Brenda Peake** (1:14:00) and **Poppy Cartwright** (1:14:01)

Andrew obviously had the bit between his teeth because the following week he, together with partner Kate, ran the Grasmere 10k Trail race up in the Lakes – a lovely course starting and finishing at Grasmere Showground and taking in Rydal water and caves along the way. This time he took top podium spot in 39:45 with Kate on his heels in 56:15.

Just to cap a fine week of running **Andrew** took on his fellow "fast lads" in Racebests mid week **Leeds 5k series** track race at the Brownlee Centre in Leeds finishing a superb **4**<sup>th</sup> out of 162 competitors in **15:54** 

The next weekend (26<sup>th</sup>) brought something altogether different – the **Blubberhouses 25** – a tough moorland traverse across Denton and Blubberhouse moor, taking in Beamsley Beacon along the way. Organised by the Nidderdale LDWA this is another race I have actually done many moons ago when it was still a 25 miler but new paths have resulted in a slightly shorter 24 mile course starting and finishing at Bland Hill, Norwood and taking in Blubberhouses and Thruscross along the way. A tough old race on any day but three of our Pacers were blessed with perfect sunny weather – **Helen Waite** completing the course in **5hrs 10mins** closely followed in by **Cathy Stothers and Louise Holloway – Cathcart** in **5hrs 20m** 

The following day some more conventional road racing to report – the **Keighley 10k** was contested by Pacers **Brenda Peake (45:08), Poppy Cartwright (49:51), and Mike Jarvis (1hr 10m).** Both Brenda and Poppy took out 3<sup>rd</sup> place in their respective age groups – no mean feat in a very competitive race.

Meanwhile a long way South, **Amanda Connolly and daughter Charlotte** ran the **Cardiff Half marathon** – Charlotte putting one over on Mum in **2hrs 04m** with Amanda very close behind in **2hrs 25m**.

That all brings us once again to **PECO!** 

They thought it was all over – well it is now!

The final act of the PECO season took place in Bramley Falls Woods on the 13<sup>th</sup> – **the PECO Relays** – three tough 2.5 mile laps. Sadly no Pacers participation this time but the winners were **Horsforth Harriers** in a cumulative time of **41:19** followed **by "Premature Acceleration"** (Hyde Park Harriers incognito) in **41:50** and third **Abbey Runners in 42:47**

**Andrew Smith and Richard Walker** were our marathon heroes – Andrew lived up to his designation as the "Flying Doctor" recording a fine sub 3hr run

in **2:48:44** (that's more or less 6.5 min mileing!) with Richard just behind him in **3:03:59** – huge congratulations to them both.

Closer to home nine Pacers took on the tough **Baildon Boundary Way** with **Brenda Peake** leading the team home in 1:52:41 followed by **Sarah Lund** (1:54:34), Poppy Cartwright (1:56:39), Craig Milner (1:59:19), Gina Williams (2:07:17), Cathy Stothers (2:14:08), Graham Turner (2:14:35), Izzy Hainsworth-Brear (2:17:05 PB) and Louise Biddulph (2:42:58).

The race was won by **Phil Boynton** of Horsforth Harriers in **1:22:23** and first lady home was **Charlotte Mason** (City of York AC) in **1:33:00** 

Wrapping up the racing report for the month is new member **Richard Haynes** who ran a great **43:50 PB** in the **Bramham Park 10k Trail Race**
