# **RESULTS, RESULTS, RESULTS!**

"Flaming June" has given way to "Boiling July" as I write this in my home office with every window in the house wide open, reading inspiring stories from **Endure 24** and the **Ilkley Half**. Sadly they will have to wait until next month as there are lots of great ACP performances to report on this month! Thanks to all those who have sent in their results to me – please keep them coming !

So here is our eighth "**Results Roundup**" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing !

Our eighth Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (June 2022). – a busy month with a dozen races to report on plus Harrogate League and YVAA (Yorkshire Vets) where our runners are making an immediate impact on the age group prizes !

Once again **Richard Walker** has provided the **Club Time Trial** results – this time for June – building on some swift times in May.

**Otley Chevin Fell race** gets us off the mark this month – appropriately on the 1<sup>st</sup> June – starting on the cobbles of Station Rd in Otley, this race blasts straight up the side of the Chevin via the White House and emerges onto Surprise View, follows the ridge along before turning sharp left and retracing the same suicidal route back down to Station Rd. On a fine sunny evening our very own "Master of Pain", **Richard Walker** clocked 22:54 for the 2.9 miles. Skyrac AC's Charlotte Rawston broke the course record in 19:54 ( her first fell race having just turned 18!)

The following Sunday (5<sup>th</sup>) **Derek Lee** took on the **Grimsby 10k** and clocked **38:46** – a 10k PB for Derek !

Meanwhile Margaret Britton donned her cycle helment and took part in Le Petit Depart, a tough 38 mile cycling sportif starting and finishing in Skipton and tracing a route around the Dales – some of you will know that Margaret has been battling to recover from a serious ankle injury so her time of **3hrs:35:26** was all the more impressive.True grit !

One of the local milestones in the racing calendar followed next on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> June – the Otley 10 has been a fixture for local runners for many years, famed for its tough hilly 10 mile route through Leathley and Lindley. This year saw a slightly amended route tackled by ten ACP runners along with 274 others. – our runners all ran on or below the 90 minute mark. Andrew Humphries led the team home in 57:56 (4<sup>th</sup> overall), followed by Richard Walker (1:06:19), Poppy Cartwright (1:16:47), Brenda Peake (1:18:21), Sarah Lund (1:21:16), Robbie Dawrant (1:22:00), Molina M.B (1:24:06), Tom Gifford (1:24:20), Graham Turner (1:25:04) and Sarah Podesta (1:32:35). Race winner was Tom Hodgson(Halifax) 54:52 and first lady home Sarah Flaherty (Bingley) (1:06:08)

Another local favourite made a welcome return to the calendar post Covid on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> June – Up The Odda is a two lap trail race starting and finishing at Hawkesworth Primary School (for which the race raises funds). The race encompasses a 10k and a new relay format for "Duos". ACP entered four "Duo" teams – Team Humphries who clocked 46:11 (1<sup>st</sup>), Team Walker 46:25 (2<sup>nd</sup>), Team Grindley 1:00:43 and Team Chruscht 1:07:28 – 14 teams ran !

In the main 10k race seven ACP runners took part – **Brenda Peake (57:07** – 2<sup>nd</sup>/20), Graham Turner (58:23), Francesca Gatenby (1:01:19), Eleanor Thompson (1:04:54), Sarah Podesta (1:06:52), Mike Jarvis (1:15:20), Carole Keighley (1:18:34). 108 ran – race winners Jack Cummings (Ilkley) 37:38 & Rebecca Flaherty (Bingley) 42:42.

On the same Saturday three Pacers ran the **Summer Extravaganza** – one of Grim Up Norths multi format races - incorporating all distances from 5k to Ultra Marathon – starting and finishing on the Leeds and Liverpool canal at Kirkstall – **Bernie Murby (1:16:44) and Sally Russ (1:16:48)** chose the 10k race whilst **Anne Proctor (returning to racing) ran 5k in 37:52**.

The following day three Pacers made the trip up to beautiful Lake Coniston for the **Coniston Marathon and Half.** There was plenty of tough competition with 115 runners entered but **Sarah Lund (4;46:49 & 5<sup>th</sup> place) and Gina Williams (5:06:47 & 13<sup>th</sup>)** turned in fine marathon performances. Our third Pacer **Janice Chruscht** opted for the Half and ran an equally impressive time of **2:23:27** on what is a tough undulating course.

Fast forward to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> and a quick Fell Race dash up and down Beamsley Beacon appealed to Pete Branney and Gina Williams, Pete clocking 44:44 and Gina 59:27

21<sup>st</sup> June marked the return of the ever popular Solstice Saunter running through the glorious valley between Bolton Abbey to Barden and return in aid of Sue Ryder Manorlands Hospice. ACP fielded six runners as follows – Poppy Cartwright (40:57), Sarah Lund (41:40), Robbie Dawrant (41:43), Amy Llewellyn (55:53), Cheryl Duerden (58:35) and Louise Biddulph (1:00:38)

22<sup>nd</sup> June saw the monthly Leeds 5k track series staged on the Brownlee track – ACP have had some great results across the series with Andrew Humphries always up amongst the leaders. Andrew did it again finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> on the night in a nippy 15:33, a performance good enough to clinch 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall across the series – many congratulations Andrew !

Sliding towards the end of the month, Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> was the ECCUP 10 miler – another very popular local race around the Eccup Reservoir and surrounds, starting and finishing in Adel. Although undulating through mixed terrain it produces a fair share of PB's – our five Pacers all ran some great sub 2 hr times – leading them home Richard Walker (1:03:54), Brenda Peake (1:16:43), Craig Hoos (1:21:25), Andy Coupe (1:40:41) and Simon Walker (1:42:03) – Race winner was Graham Rush – Leeds City AC (52:23) and first lady Zara Knappy (Rotherham) in 1:02:28

Meanwhile more reservoir racng, this time around Swinsty up in the Washburn valley where the **Swinsty Trail race** attracted Pacers **Richard Haynes (44:35) and Mike Jarvis (1:01:57).** Sadly this race didn't attract a big attendance possibly because of the Eccup Race which has a big following

The honour of being "last Pacer racers" in June fell jointly to "flying doctors" **Andrew Smith and Helen Alcock** – Helen tackled the lovely 6kMT evening

race staged by Pudsey and Bramley AC quaintly titled **"Rush Around the Rhubarb**". It was on her way home from work so she popped in and stewed the Rhubarb in **33:20** despite having to battle a pesky stinger that objected to having its evening disturbed !

Andrew Smith decided to have a tilt at a fast time in the annual Hyde Park Summer Mile – held in Hyde Park, Leeds (Woodhouse Moor parkrun). This ever popular evening "eyeballs out" one mile blast is run in heats selected according to times estimated by the entrant themselves. Running in the penultimate heat, Andrew clocked a superfast sub 5 minute mile to cross the line in 4:59:30 and finished 17<sup>th</sup> overall out of 278 runners.

#### Harrogate & District Summer Race League.

Getting to the "sharp end" of the Harrogate League competition with the two final races of the series in June before the handicap race to be staged at Otley in July. Astrophysicist Brian Cox is trying to work out the final standings !

The third race in the series was staged by **Ilkley** Harriers, starting and finishing at Ilkley RUFC. ACP fielded a strong contingent in what is probably the most local race for us with 17 Pacers taking on a tough ascent up Owler Park with a kinder mid section and a fast finish down Carters Lane, returning along Denton Road. **Simon Jones** led the Pacers home in **30:25** to claim an excellent 9<sup>th</sup> place followed by **Richard Walker** who bagged 2<sup>nd</sup> **Mv45** in **31:47**. Next in were **Richard Haynes** (**35:28**),**Craig Milner** (**36:51**), **& Craig Hoos** (**37:05**). First Pacer Lady home was **Poppy Cartwright in 37:07** with **Brenda Peake** running her close in **37:19 to claim 2<sup>nd</sup> Fv45 prize**.

Our remaining Pacers ran superbly to all finish under 50 mins – **Robbie Dawrant (39:04), Phil Priestley (39:51, Kate Humphries (40:15), Graham Turner (40:22), Francesca Gatenby (41:17), Paul Grindley (42:38), Janice Chruscht (44:45), Helen Alcock (47:14) Sophie Bromley (48:15) and Carole Keighley (48:17).** Scott Harrington (Otley)continued his fine form by winning the race in 27:04 whilst Emily Gibbins (Ilkley) was first lady home in 30:31 - 385 ran the race

Next up it was the turn of **Skipton AC** to host the 4<sup>th</sup> race on a challenging course starting and finishing at Aireville Park via Thorlby and Stirton villages. Nine Pacers on duty this time and again all finished well inside the 50 minute mark.

ACP Runners and riders were **Richard Walker** (32:01, **Derek Lee** (33:55), **Richard Haynes** (34:58), **Craig Milner** (38:42), **Poppy Cartwright once again first Pacer Lady home in 37:53 followed by Robbie Dawrant** (38:54), **Paul Grindley** (44:05), **Sophie Bromley** (44:52) and Helen Alcock (46:26)

## **YVAA race series**

ACP have only recently affiliated to Yorkshire Veterans Athletic Association (YVAA) but already our Pacers are making their mark in the race series. The series consists of **Grand Prix races** (usually mid week trails of approx 5.5 miles) and **Championship races** (already established club races at the various recognised distances – 5k, 5 miles, 10k, 10 miles etc. where Yorkshire Championship Trophies are awarded.

Grand Prix Middleton Park, Leeds (using the PECO course) ran on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June (7pm) and featured three of our Pacers all of whom claimed podium places – Richard Walker (36:16 & 1<sup>st</sup> Mv45), Brenda Peake (43:22 & 2<sup>nd</sup> Fv45) and Gina Williams (44:23 & 3<sup>rd</sup> Fv45 – prizes were claimed - many congrats !

The Eccup 10 (reported on above) was the chosen YVAA 10 Mile Championship race this season – always ultra competitive and attracting some of the top runners from across Yorkshire, getting on the podium here is a tall order. Richard Walker (6<sup>th</sup>/64) and Brenda Peake (5<sup>th</sup>/40) were very close.

The next **Yorkshire Championship** race was the **Helen Windsor 10k** over in Halifax on 6<sup>th</sup> July (without giving too much away Richard ran a blinder and secured 2<sup>nd</sup> Mv45 spot to put Pacers on the medal table plus he has become 10k "poster boy" on the website !)

The next YVAA Grand Prix race is on 26<sup>th</sup> July at Bingley – full details can be found at <u>https://www.yvaa.org/event/gp-2022-race-4-bingley/</u>

Further **Grand Prix** at Stainland (Aug 14<sup>th</sup>), Queensbury (23<sup>rd</sup>) and Ackworth (25<sup>th</sup> Sept). Last two **Championships races**, Major Stone Half (4<sup>th</sup> Sept) & Hull Marathon (25<sup>th</sup> Sept) where YVAA trophies will be presented.
