RESULTS, RESULTS!

I know it's a cliché but I've got to say it - **Phew, What a Scorcher!** If you raced in August you will have had a torrid time on some hot days. For some odd reason this month our Pacers have been doing far more racing off road, fell racing and all sorts of adventurous stuff – perhaps it was the prospect of some refreshing river crossings that spurred folks on!

Thanks to all those who have sent in their results to me – please keep them coming!

So here is our tenth "Results Roundup" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

Our tenth Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (**August 2022**). – a much quieter racing month due to family holidays I guess – the **YVAA** season is coming to a close with two more Grand Prix races put to bed this month and only one more to come (Ackworth on 25th September)

Once again **Richard Walker** will provided the **Club Time Trial** results – this time for August – those times are coming down!

Steve Tindall kicked off our racing month by strapping on his trail shoes for the first time in ages and running the **Roundhill Fell race.** This race, organised by Otley AC starts off in the village of Timble and heads off up the trail to Beamsley Beacon and back via Denton Moor. Steve clocked 1:49:04 – 126 ran.

The following week (13th) the off road theme continued with "**Team Alcock**" descending on the **Arncliffe Gala Fell Race.** The Arncliffe Gala is a typical Dales village celebration featuring local produce stalls, terrier races, coconut shies etc. It also hosts a lovely 4 mile road race out and back along the valley and as a finale, a spectacular dash up and down the local fell. **Helen**, husband **David** plus **Charlie** and **Alfie** took on the Fell race challenge with David leading the team home in 13:44 (20th/134) followed by Helen in 22:47 (105th/134). Charlie had a great race in the under 9's crossing the line in 06:27 (6th/27) with Alfie finishing in 13:49 – a great effort!

Readers of last months "Roundup" will recall the **Endure 24hr Race** at Bramham Park in which our Pacers did so well. On the **19th August** a "mini" version of the same relay format was staged around **Leeds City Centre Docklands.** This time the challenge was to complete as many one mile laps as possible in one hour. **Richard & daughter Evie Walker plus Carole Keighley**, standing in for an injured Paul Grindley, clocked up a fantastic 10 laps in the hour. Pacer **Janice Chruscht** also took part (but dare I say, moonlighting for another team !)

On the 20th **Team Alcock**, encouraged by their storming of the Arncliffe Fell Race the previous week, returned to the fray at **Gargrave Show**. Minus husband David this time, **Helen, Charlie and Alfie** took on this challenging 5k course over varied terrain complete with river crossing and a steep climb up Flasby Fell. Helen crossed the line in an impressive 44:51 whilst Charlie, running in the shorter under 12's race clocked 8:33 (11th) and Alfie 11:59 in the under 9's race. Bravo!

Just a day later **Louise Holloway-Cathcart and Janice Chruscht** ran the inaugural Jane Tomlinson "**Yorkshire Dales Festival Trail race**" – an interesting format running the 16 miles from Ribblehead Viaduct back to Settle complete with 1500ft of climb (no flat ground around there!).

Race participants were ferried out to Ribblehead by coach, dropped off and told to head back to Settle with all speed! **Louise** nicked Pacer line honours in 3:29:48 whilst **Janice**, hot on her heels crossed in 3:31:31 – a great effort on a warm day especially when the organisers had neglected to provide the promised water station at 7 miles!

YVAA race series

ACP have only recently affiliated to Yorkshire Veterans Athletic Association (YVAA) but already our Pacers are making their mark in the race series. The series consists of **Grand Prix races** (usually mid week trails of approx 5.5 miles) and **Championship races** (already established club races at the various recognised distances – 5k, 5 miles, 10k, 10 miles etc. where Yorkshire Championship Trophies are awarded.

Two YVAA Grand Prix races took place during the month – first off at West Vale, Halifax on the 14th organised by Stainland Lions RC. Richard Walker was our lone Pacer standard bearer at this race picking up the 2nd Mv45 prize in 39:20 although recent second claim member Alyson Blakeley, running for her first claim club Roundhay Runners, knocked off the 1st Fv45 prize in an excellent 48:49. Stainland have taken the series by storm this season and it was hoped that the rest would have a good chance of stealing a march on them at this, their home race. No such luck! Stainlands Gav Mulholland claimed first spot in 34:01 and Mags Beever first lady prize in 40:05 – 142 ran.

The second and penultimate Grand Prix in the series was hosted by **Queensbury.** This time Richard left it to the Pacer ladies to carry the flag and they didn't disappoint – **Gina Williams** taking the 1st Fv45 prize in 50:51 (13th lady / 75) with second claimer **Alyson Blakeley** breathing down her neck in 50:52. Line honours were exactly the same as at West Vale (36:25 & 41:57). 190 ran

The **overall YVAA standings** are interesting – in our first season ACP stand 17th in the league table of 32 clubs – a magnificent effort given that only four Pacers have participated so far. Points are awarded at each race dependent on placing and so far **Richard Walker** sits in 8th place out of 45 runners in the M45 category with 1131 points from four races, **Gina Williams 4th /34** in her Fv45 group from four races (535 points). **Brenda Peake 24th** in the same category (138 points from 1 race), **Helen Waite 23rd/31** in her Fv40 group (127 points from 1 race). **Alyson Blakeley** (2nd claim) lies 2nd in the Fv45 group (679 points from 5 races).

The last **Grand Prix** race is coming up at Ackworth (Sept 25th), Last two **Championships races**, Major Stone Half (4th Sept) & Hull Marathon (25th Sept) where YVAA trophies will be presented. Full details at https://www.yvaa.org/
