RESULTS, RESULTS!

Its hard to believe but Results Roundup celebrates its first birthday this month! That's twelve months of recording some great ACP racing outcomes as we emerged from the pandemic embargo.

Here's a few interesting facts collated from the last years editions – we have flown the **Pacers flag** at no less than **124 different races** all over the country and a couple overseas.

We have completed 410 parkruns at 50 different venues ranging from Portrush in Northern Ireland to Exmouth in Devon and Strathclyde to Scunthorpe with lots in between! Top of the pops with Pacers was Roberts Park with 142 visits, followed by Chevin on 69 just pipping Lister Park into third spot on 68. Skipton & Woodhouse Moor, Leeds tied on 17 each. Craig Hoos made a valient effort to get Armley (13) & Whitby Cinder Path (10) into contention but he does have the consolation prize of being our most travelled parkrunner! Meanwhile Andy Gledhill clocked up his 300th parkrun & Debbie Bland her 250th

The parkrun "Speedypants" prize goes to to Andrew Humphries (no surprises there then!) who broke the course record at Brigg with a blistering 15:58 only to go 2 seconds faster at sunny Scunny but finish second in 15:56. Richard Walker and Derek Lee have been hunting him down all year with Richards magnificent 18:47 at Lister Park just pipping Derek to the runners up spot (19:00). Our speedster lady parkrunner was Sarah Lund (Exmouth 21:34) whilst Debbie Blands Fv65 course record at Roberts Park set exactly a year ago still stands (26:33)

Thanks to all those who have sent in their results to me – please keep them coming!

So here is our twelfth "Results Roundup" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

Our twelfth Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (October 2022)

No **Time Trial** results to report this time – the Summer series has now ended. Richard will keep the final consolidated results for the series and the "Lord Archer" prizes under wraps until our annual prizegiving & **AGM** now rescheduled for **December 2**nd.

No harm in repeating those early October Marathon results as reported last month......

ACP had four runners involved in the **London Marathon** – **Kate Humphries** first home for us in 3:50:49, **Charlotte Connolly** (5:23:23), **Jen SP** (5:41:58) and **Heather Freeman-Dawson** (5:43:17)

Meanwhile Chester Marathon entertained Poppy Cartwright (3:31:02) and Sarah Lund (3:37:01) – both terrific times for the event.

Carole Keighley took on the Kielder Marathon after warming up on the Yorkshireman the week before! She crossed the line in 5:46:54 – Bravo Carole

On the same weekend **Craig Milner** took to the trails, running the **Kirkstall 7** which is a long established 7 mile trail run starting and finishing at Kirkstall Abbey, covering the riverside paths and fields along the Aire Valley out to Rodley and back. 255 ran with Craig finishing well up in 58th (52:23)

In a similar vein, **Debbie Bland** took on the much hillier **Hopton 10k MT** race using the woodland paths and trails around Mirfield with a mile of tarmac to start and finish. Another popular race run in aid of the local Primary school, Debbie, who was testing out her recently injured ankle, ran 1:12:30.

The following weekend (9th) saw a new race enter the calendar – the **Morley 10k**. Run by the Morley running club the race starts at Morley Bottoms with a 1.5k steep climb up to the town centre and covers a roller coaster route around the town which includes a lot of climbing, culminating in a steep finish up the hill into the town centre past the Town Hall to finish in Queen Street. **Brenda Peake**, warming up for her Yorkshire Marathon the following week, ran a superb race to finish 1st Lv45 and second lady overall in 43:36 whilst **Debbie Bland** also won her Fv65 age group in 56:58. 744 ran.

Moving on a week (15th/16th) the South Pennines were the stage for a Pacers day out to Derbyshire for the **Ladybower Reservoir Trail Ultra** set in the magnificent scenery surrounding a pretty empty reservoir with wonderful views on a sunny day to take the mind off the pain of the Ultra! Running alongside the Ultra was a Half Marathon option which our intrepid team of **Janice Chruscht** and **Louise Holloway** reported as rather long at 14.7 miles!

Running together they clocked 3:11:28. Meanwhile **Helen Waite, Sarah Lund and Carole Keighley** took on the long route (50k) – Helen running a terrific time of 6:28:23 (3rd in her age group), Sarah 7:28:16 (2nd in her age group) and Carole, with Kielder Marathon still in her legs, finishing in 9:25:23

The following day (16th) the Pennine theme continued, **Debbie Bland** taking on her third hilly race in a row – the **Holmfirth 10k**. This race has two previous incarnations as the Holmfirth 15, then the 10k run around the town of Holmfirth in Summer Wine country and now recently revived on a new route based in the village of Hade Edge perched high up alongside Holme Moss. The route is a hilly loop starting with a 2k climb up Hade Edge to then descend around the huge Winscar Reservoir before turning back at Dunsop Bridge and climbing back up to the 8k marker, ending with a fast descent to the finish on a playing field! Debbie finished in just under the hour (59:42)

A longer challenge awaited runners of the **Yorkshire Marathon** running out of York on the 16th – **Brenda Peake and Andrew Humphries** flew the Pacers flag and both had excellent races, all the hard lead up training paying off for Brenda who finished in 3:21:46 whilst Andrew, fresh from his heroics in Berlin just weeks before, ran another sub 3 hr race in 2:54:53.

Much further South second claim runner **Alyson Blakeley** ran the **Bath Half Marathon** which attracted a top quality field of 6,900 runners from all over the country. Finishing well up in the top third of the race, Alyson finished in 1:50:54.

The following week (23rd) Leeds hosted its own prestige 10k, the hugely popular **Abbey Dash**, well known as a fast PB course out and back from Leeds City Centre and turning at Kirkstall Abbey. 3,751 runners took up the challenge including seven of our Pacers led home by **Poppy Cartwright** (42:39), **Richard Haynes** (43:14), **Robbie Dawrant** (44:13) and **Craig Hoos** (45:16), Second claim **Alyson Blakeley** (48:44) new member **Liz Porteus** (49:23) and **Eleanor Thompson** (50:13) all at or under the 50 minute mark. Race winner was Andy Milligan in an astonishing 29:22, First Lady home was Jessica Warner-Judd in 32:18.

The Leeds and York 5k series have been ticking along all season giving the fast mob an outlet on the track to post some startlingly fast times – our own **Richard Walker** gave the York track a pasting, clocking 18:53, just a smidgeon outside his previous best at Lister Park parkrun of 18:47 whilst **Poppy Cartwright** shot round the Leeds circuit in 20:07 (rumour has it that may be a PB for Poppy?)

We've reached the end of October and on the 30th it was left to **Andy Gledhill** to post a 26:25 at the **Bradford City 5k** whilst **Debbie Bland** ventured over the "Dark Side" to take on the Lancastrians in the **Accrington 10k** – another hill fest with the first 5k all uphill but a consolation 2k fast finish. Debbie grabbed the spoils winning her age group of five in 58:26.

The final act of the month was our very own **Club Handicap race** where Pacers gather to run the Chevin Chase route and guess their finishing time (no watches/phones/Sat navs/ secret clocks allowed! The winner is the Pacer who arrives back with a time nearest to their "guesstimate". All this is followed by a hearty club breakfast (which probably accounts for the fact that 13 Pacers

turned out of bed on a Sunday morning to run!). So here are the runners and riders with predicted time followed by actual time in red:-
