RESULTS, RESULTS!

Happy New Year everyone and welcome to this our 14th edition of **Results Roundup** – not a vintage month for race results due in part to folk

concentrating on their Christmas shopping and not helped by the long spell of
really icy weather through December BUT racing there was, including some
great **PECO** results, the ever popular **Auld Lang Syne Fell** race featuring
fancy dress aplenty, a scary **Winter Solstice** headtorch adventure in the dark
around Bingley St Ives and the small matter of that little race we ourselves
stage on Boxing Day!

As per usual I've attached a more comprehensive list of upcoming races to tempt you all at the end of this Roundup.

Here is our fourteenth "Results Roundup" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

This Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (**December 2022**)

No one sent me any race results prior to the second **PECO Cross Country** race of the season held out at **Temple Newsam**, **Leeds on 18th December** so lets kick off with that:-

Given that both our Ladies and Mens teams are in great form there was a fair bit at stake following on from a close run contest at Middleton Park in Race 1 between ouselves and Kirkstall Harriers. 412 Men and 304 Ladies contested **Race 2** on a tough and muddy course around **Temple Newsam Park**, featuring the mother of all water jumps and some pretty intimidating slippery climbs.

Both mens and ladies teams fielded eight Pacers plus **Fraser Lee** flying the Pacers flag in the **Junior 1 mile race** in which he finished a notable 35th / 130 in 8:22. Bravo Fraser – Here's how the big boys and girls got on!

Teams (Race 2): Mens race: Kirkstall Harriers (814), ACP (940), Ackworth (1016): Ladies race: ACP (362); Horsforth Fellandale (363), Kippax (791). Counter intuitively the least points scored means the higher up the table you are as points are awarded according to your race place ($1^{st} = 1$ point, $10^{th} = ten$ points and so on).

Cumulative Tables (Div 2) after 2 races:

Mens Team: 2nd/14. Ladies Team 1st/14

Mens Vets Team: 6th/14. Ladies Vets Team: 4th/14

So all to play for by both Mens & Ladies Teams in Race 3 coming up on January 22nd at West Park (Leeds)

Hot on the heels of PECO another "mudfest", but this time in the dark. It took place along the trails of Bingley St Ives – a Winter Solstice race organised by Sue Ryder in aid of Manorlands Hospice and a twin of the Summer Solstice race run along the trails of Bolton Abbey on mid summers day. Organised into a 10k and 5k race, 184 runners decided they liked the idea of running in lots of mud in the dark with just headtorches for illumination! Eleven of our Pacers also liked the idea, eight brave souls running the full 10k whilst three more sensible folk thought that 5k might be wiser just four days before Christmas!

On Boxing day it was the turn of our very own Chevin Chase, a 40 year old institution in the racing calendar, this year with a much expanded entry list of 2000 runners which sold out well before race day. In the event there must have been some serious Christmas hangovers amongst that entry because 1,542 turned up on the day and enjoyed good racing conditions along with the usual ample serving of mud & water. Four Pacers took up the challenge, Richard Walker (50:37), Aron Fulton (52:23), Poppy Cartwright (53:53) and Holly Marcantonio (1:15:11). Race winner this year was Dom Coy (U/A) in 38:29 whilst first lady home was Alice Leake (Leeds City) in 47:16

The following day **Debbie Bland** raced the **Jolly Holly Jog**, a lovely 10kMT race hosted by Ripon Runners and taking in the trails around the Studley Royal & Fountains Abbey deer park. Another "mudfest" but mercifully rain free, **Debbie ran 1:07:29** to finish 435th/572.

The racing month closed off on New years Eve 2022 with the traditional **Auld** Lang Syne Fell Race – a 6.7 mile muddy slog around Haworth Moors taking in Penistone Hill, Top Withens, Ponden Clough and Stanbury and including a not inconsiderable 1000ft of climb. Its also traditional to wear fancy dress and there were some interesting sights to behold at the Finish!

Four crazy Pacers had a crack at this – **Gina Williams (1:12:28), Alyson Blakeley (2nd claim 1:15:47); Louise Biddulph (1:43:58) and Carole Keighley (1:44:02)**
