RESULTS, RESULTS, RESULTS!

Welcome to our second **ACP Results Roundup** of 2023 and once more apologies for the slight delay in the publishing due to your esteemed correspondent once again living it up in Spain (top tip – buy shares in Jet 2 !) – Another great crop of results from our Pacers in February so plenty to report on this month.

This Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (**February 2023**) but once again it makes sense to run things up to the time of writing so it also encompasses the first two weekends of March. Things will return to normal when I manage to stop my good lady booking trips away !

Here is our sixteenth "**Results Roundup**" – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing !

In last months "Roundup" I covered the **Rombalds Stride** on the 4th Feb with some impressive runs by our 15 Pacers (**Sarah Lund** topping the pile with a sub 4 hour **3:57:56** & 4th in her age group) and the following day **Andrew Humphries** swift **31:18** to earn him 7th place at the **Dewsbury 10k**.

So we pick up the action the following week (11th) and the **Liversedge Half Marathon** – a tough test around the hilly countryside around Roberttown and the Spen Valley. Long known as a good prep race for a Spring Marathon, 363 runners turned up including our own **Poppy Cartwright** who ran a great PB time of **1:35:38** to finish second of eighteen in her age group.

Jacob Shannon (York Knavesmire) took line honours in 1:14:21 and local runner Sally Armitage (Ilkley Harriers) was first lady home in 1:24:53.

Next up on the 19th was another in the Grim Up North series of multi distance events staged along the canal towpath – this latest one with the happy title **"The Bingley Bollocks"** ! Three Pacers turned up along with 16 other curious runners eager to discover what the Bingley Bollocks looked like ! Claire McColl (30:16 & 2nd lady), Rachel Jovanovic (30:27 & 3rd lady) and Anne Proctor (39:38) made short work of the 5k out and back course – no feedback yet on what they discovered in Bingley !

Poppy Cartwright took to the Brownlee track in Leeds on the 22nd to contest the latest installment of the Leeds 5k track series – running a swift 20:20. This keenly contested series brings out some fast runners and serial winner Marcos Valero (Valley Striders) was beaten into second place by unattached runner Jamie Rashbrook who took line honours in 15:04. First lady home was Stella Cross(Wetherby) in 18:28.

No results reported in for the last weekend in February but the 5th March (PECO Weekend) finds us on the sunny Costa del Sol, Spain where the stage belonged to Margaret Britton (51:58) and Debbie Bland (52:51) who polished off a fine age group 1-2 win in the Torre de Mar 10k, planting the ACP flag on the Podium & beating 3rd place by over 12 minutes !

So we end up on the **11th March** in glorious **Dentdale** for the 14.2 mile run up and down the pretty valley. The race raises much needed funds for the local primary school. Given the heavy snowfall of previous days that caused most parkruns and many races to be cancelled it was surprising that this event survived. Three Pacers along with 109 others took part in the race – **Richard Walker first home for us in 1:33:24 (& 3rd Mv45), Nick Leathley (2:22:46) and Carole Keighley (2:31:01).**

On the same weekend the latest of the Punk Panther Ultra series – **The Welcome Way** – ran along a challenging off road route with plenty of snow, starting at Otley and taking the high moorland above Askwith, Denton and then climbing across the valley to Burley Moor, Baildon and back to Otley via the Chevin. The race offers four choices of distance, 50 miles, 34 miles, 20 miles and a Half Marathon.

Five Pacers chose the 20 miler – Gina Williams and second claim Alyson Blakely home in 4:30:21, Izzy H.B next in 5:23:15 then Sharon Elms and Sue Hulme in 5:45:22. Finally to bring us bang up to date **on 12th March** – the **Thirsk 10 Mile Road Race** – a flat(ish) course starting and finishing near Thirsk racecourse with a reputation for dishing out PB's. 751 runners took up the challenge including our own **Poppy Cartwright (1:09:26 & 4th/50) and Brenda Peake (1:11:13 & 5th/82).** Race winner was Graham Rush (Leeds City) 49:03 and first lady home Faye Birkby (Pudsey) in 1:00:25

Next up – **PECO** - After the first three races in the series Pacers teams were flying high having carried their good form from 2021/22 season into this years series so there was a fair bit at stake following on from two close run contests at **Middleton Park in Race 1** between ourselves and Kirkstall Harriers and **Race 2** on a tough and muddy course around **Temple Newsam Park**, featuring the mother of all water jumps and some pretty intimidating slippery climbs.

In the last Roundup we left the action at **Race 3** (**West Park**) which saw the ladies team put a lot of distance between themselves and nearest rivals Horsforth Fellandale and the mens team maintain the pressure on leaders Kirkstall. So all to play for in **Race 4** (**Middleton Park, Leeds**) run on **19th Feb**. Pacers fielded eight ladies and ten chaps plus juniors **Monty Walker** (9:06) and **Fraser Lee** (9:49) who ran in the Junior Mile race.

Counter intuitively the least points scored means the higher up the table you are as points are awarded according to your race place ($1^{st} = 1$ point, $10^{th} =$ ten points and so on).
