# RESULTS, RESULTS!

Welcome to our seventh **ACP Results Roundup** of 2023.— As I look out of the window whilst compiling this roundup it is pouring with rain and blowing a gale which must mean only one thing – its school holidays!

I'm guessing that the holiday season is impacting the running scene as there are fewer race results reported in this month but still plenty of great running to tell you about from our members, with **Lakeland Trail Ultras** (not for the faint hearted!), **Eccup 10** and a very well supported **Ilkley Half** with some standout performances from our 15 ACP members running.

The final race of the **Harrogate League** season – the Handicap Race - took place on the 20<sup>th</sup> and Debbie Bland bookended the month with a fine race up in Wensleydale – the **James Herriot 14k Trail race.** 

This month also featured the start of our new **ACP parkrun Challenge** – run over 16 weeks 15<sup>th</sup> July to 28<sup>th</sup> October, this has sparked a lot of interest and started the competitive spirit going on a Saturday morning. Lots of good feedback so far and still a long way to go before trophies are held aloft at our AGM!

This Roundup will endeavor to recapture the headlines from last month (July 2023) – as ever it is only as good as the info you send me so apologies if that extra special PB is missing!

First race across the start line this month took place amongst the dramatic scenery of the Lake District on the 8<sup>th</sup> July. The Lakeland Trails Series offers a mighty challenge to those who like to run long distances and climb big hills! The series offers a variety of distances from 14k through 23k, 50k to an

eye watering 100k (62 miles 241 yds in old money) and an even more eye watering 10,500 ft of climb! The series is exceptionally well organised and supported and the 100k starts at midnight in Ambleside. 102 ran it, amongst which were Pacer Ultra fans **Sarah Lund and Helen Ward.** Climbing out of Windermere towards Rydal Water the route splits from the "shorter" routes and heads along the appropriately named "Coffin Trail" to Grasmere and the Langdale Valley and back to Ambleside via five mountain passes. Sarah and Helen, running as a pair, clocked **21 hours and 24 minutes.** A superb effort when you consider that 26 runners retired along the way and that they were racing against a 23 hour cut off.

We do have sensible Pacers around too and **Janice Chruscht** chose the **23k** (14 miles) route which starts at a more civilised 11am and allows magnificent daylight views across Windermere, Rydal and the Langdale Valley. **Janice clocked 3hrs 56.05** on a warm humid day. Hats off to all three!

The Eccup 10 miler which followed this on the 9<sup>th</sup> July seems a bit tame by comparison but in fact is a stiff test, especially on a warm and humid day. Organised by Abbey Runners and with our second claimer Simon Jones as RD, the race always attracts a big entry (730 this year). Five Pacers gave this a crack led home by Richard Walker (1:08:28), Nick Lee (1:10:23), Brenda Peake (1:10:48 & 1<sup>st</sup> Fv50), Helen Illman (1:20:37) and Debbie Bland, running her last ever race as a Fv65, (1:32:21). Race winner was Matt Grieve (Leeds City) in 53:09 and first lady Eilidh Bell (Leeds City) 58:55.

Fast forward a week and the wonderful spell of hot sunny weather during June had collapsed into a semi monsoon! Sadly this co-incided with the **Ilkley Half Marathon** which always attracts a huge entry (1,758 this year!).

Fifteen Pacers braved the wet conditions and were led home by Andrew Humphries (1:09:31 & 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall), followed by Richard Walker (1:27:25), Jack Ogalbe (1:29:09) and Nick Lee (1:32:18). Brenda Peake led our ladies contingent across the line in 1:32:28 (2<sup>nd</sup> Fv50) followed by Poppy Cartwright (1:38:52). Richard Haynes clocked 1:40:30, Richard Crossland 1:42:35, Robbie Dawrant 1:47:20 and Simon Walker 1:53:33. Sarah Podesta running with Rhona Neilson crossed the line in 1:59:43 & 2:00:41 closely followed in by Sophie Bromley (2:02:14) and Holly Marcantonio (2:03:00).

Catherine Moody-Keene (2:13:22) and Heather Fulton (2:18:56) completed the Pacers team in what were challenging conditions. Race winner was Lawrence Mc Court (1:07:06) and first lady was Ilkley Harriers Sally

Armitage (1:22:19).

Four days later (20<sup>th</sup> July) Pacers were in action again, this time in Ripon for the final race of the **Harrogate and District Summer League** – the handicap race. Due to summer holidays etc the team was a bit depleted but five Pacers gave it their best shot – **Pete Branney** (33:49), **Owain Gwilym** (34:39) **Richard Haynes** (35:27), **Aron Fulton** (36:43) and **Janice Chruscht** (44:09). - N:B These are "net" times but on Handicap "Gross Times" the sequence looks like this – (18<sup>th</sup>) **Richard Haynes** (1:06:28), (63<sup>rd</sup>) **Owain Gwilym** (1:07:40), (105<sup>th</sup>) **Aron Fulton** (1:08:14), (171<sup>st</sup>) **Pete Branney** 

(1:08:50) and (245th) Janice Chruscht (1:09:41). 301 ran on the night.

At this point you will be expecting me to explain how the handicap system works – I can't !! Only one living person has the secret formulae and its not me !. All I can say is that the winner of the **Norman Smith Handicap Trophy 2023** was **Alexandra Whapples (Fv55)** of Vocalink RC in 1:03:58 (Gross time) 42:57 (Net) - who started at 7:42pm.

No ACP runners and riders at the July **Brownlee Track 5k** this month though second claimer **Simon Jones** delivered a swift 17:01

**Debbie Bland** closed off the month by running her first "proper" race as a Fv70, the **James Herriot 14k Trail race** – a tough circuit of the moors and fells above Castle Bolton in Wensleydale with a gruelling one mile uphill start. Although the rain held off it was blowing a hooley which made conditions tricky on the tops.

Debbie duly delivered her first win in her new age group finishing  $161^{st}$  / 205 in **1hr 42** and bagged £10 for the family wine fund !

#### **ACP Parkrun Challenge.**

July 15<sup>th</sup> saw the start of our new club competition - **the parkrun Challenge**. Run over sixteen weeks the competition awards points to parkrunners each week based on their age grading at parkrun. Bonus points are also available for various achievements (course records, PB's, age group wins etc) - the Age Grading points are awarded every second and fourth week of the month whilst the other Saturdays earn bonus points only. Comp ends 28<sup>th</sup> October.

So far feed back has been positive and we currently (after 3 weeks) have 26 active parkrunners on the ladder scoring points with a tight battle at the top between **Debbie Bland (191.20 points)** and **Margaret Britton (171.78)** with **Craig Hoos** fighting hard for the lads to catch them on **163.99**.
