





2024 CHEVIN CHASE RACE NOTES

Thank you for entering the 2024 Chevin Chase; to take place on Thursday (Boxing Day) 26th December 2024. We hope you have an enjoyable and safe race and would ask that you follow the instructions of the officials and Race Marshals. For those of you who are not familiar with the course, the race is approximately 7 miles. The terrain is a combination of road and off-road, with the off-road sections varying in difficulty depending on the weather conditions.

The weather is typical for the season; please ensure you get out of the cold/wet weather as soon as possible after the race. If you are meeting/waiting for friends/family, please arrange to meet at Aireborough Leisure Centre.

START The race will start on Moorland Avenue, LS20 9EQ. There will be 4 waves, with the

first wave starting at 11.00am, the second wave at 11:05am, the third wave at 11:10 and the fourth wave at 11:15. Your race number will state which wave you are in. There will be flags for each wave at the start area. Please go to the flag for

your wave and queue behind that flag.

RACE NUMBER RACE NUMBERS WILL BE POSTED OUT. Please insert your name and details on the

back. Pin it to the front of your vest. DO NOT GIVE IT TO ANYONE ELSE. Entries are

not transferable.

CHIP TIMING Provided by Sports Timing Solutions: Your Chip Timing tag is located on your race

number, please attach the race number to the front of your torso and do not fold

or cover with any number belts or jackets.

CAR PARKING There is parking available at Aireborough Leisure Centre, Netherfield Road Car

Park, Morrisons car park and West Side Retail Park - but most of these have a 3 hour time limit and last year fines were automatically sent through ANPR to some entrants. Please check the time limits when you park. We ask competitors to car share where possible and park considerately. Late-comers often struggle to find parking spaces; please arrive earlier and be prepared to park further away.

SPECTATORS Please inform your friends/families that there are road closures in operation during

the race on Moorland Avenue, East Chevin Road, Yorkgate, Carlton Lane and West Villa Road. In addition, this year Moor Lane will be closed to traffic also. Spectators wishing to view the race on Yorkgate are requested to approach from the west side and to use the first car park, well away from the points at which the runners

cross and to obey all No Waiting Signs.

CHANGING Changing and toilet facilities are available within Aireborough Leisure Centre.

Runners are asked to remove muddy running shoes before entering the centre after the race. Additional portable toilets will be available at Guiseley Primary

School.

DRINKS STATIONS

To support sustainability, we are asking runners to carry their own water

containers. There will be water available at the halfway point for anyone needing

to refill. Water bottles will be provided at the finish (in the school grounds).

FIRST AID For First Aid, contact any Race Marshal on the course. First Aid will also be available

at the finish.

T-SHIRTS A long sleeved technical top will be awarded to each finisher unless they have

chosen to have a tree planted instead. Once you finish the race, please collect a shirt in the size you requested when you entered. Your race number will include the shirt size you requested. If you want a different size to the one you requested when you entered you will have to wait until all entrants have finished at approx

1:15 and see if you can swap your shirt for a different size.

PRIZES Trophies to the first male and first female will be presented at the finish. All other

prizes will be posted.

SAFETY The wearing of headphones or personal music systems is NOT PERMITTED. Any

runners found doing so will be disqualified. Please remain vigilant of fellow runners; overtake on the right and move to the left if you are being overtaken. DO

NOT run with dogs.

TAILWALKERS So that Marshals around the race can stand down and roads can be reopened at a

reasonable time, there will be 2 pairs of tail markers. The first pair will run the route at an approximate 1 hour 45-minute pace and stand down the Marshals and reopen the roads. The second pair will walk the route at the pace of the slowest entrants to ensure

any entrants who are slower than the 1 hour 45-minute pace are safe.

FINISH If you are planning a post-race drink or bite to eat please be aware that The Potting

Shed in Guiseley are the new sponsors for the Chevin Chase (and The Station no

longer sponsor the race).
